For us it is very satisfying to see all our content pages in so many different languages - Lithuanian, Irish and Romanian to name just a few:

We are not going to stop there either. The website is already enabled for the three further UN official languages: Arabic, Chinese and Russian. In fact a cooperation project with the Shanghai International Studies University (SISU) has already started, in which their students will translate all the content of the static part into Chinese for us to upload. We hope that this will be ready by spring 2020.


Also we have not stopped at the static part - in the dynamic part an e-translation solution has been integrated to allow users to translate any of the comments in the collaborative spaces into their own language.
