## WHY STUDENTS SHOULD MAKE THEIR OWN SPEECHES

### Discourse analysis

- It helps them to understand better how speeches work: logic, structure etc. as they will be *actively* using these techniques
- They will grasp more easily the difference between primary and secondary information (bones and flesh), as they build their own speeches that way
- They will learn as a result how better to identify and extract the main ideas from someone else's speech
- They will become accustomed to rhetorical devices, and so be able more easily to spot them in a speech and deal with them appropriately

### Language enhancement

- It will help develop language resourcefulness in their active languages (A and B)
- It is useful for developing a certain register of language
- It helps to build specialist vocabulary

# General knowledge

• They should be asked to write speeches on current affairs and topics, thereby improving their general knowledge. Active use of this knowledge will anchor it better in their minds

#### Public speaking/communication skills

- Delivering their own speeches will allow them to concentrate on communicating a message clearly (without having the added difficulty of interpreting)
- They will learn how to become convincing and engage with their audience
